TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. As part of the activities organised for 'Far from Ordinary Aussie Wine Month' in the USA, Wine Australia has organised an Australian wine immersion wine tasting to be held on the 17th of September through to the 19th of September, Eastern Daylight Time in New York from 6.30pm though to 9.30pm (the Event).
2. By purchasing a ticket to the Event, attendees agree to be bound by these terms and conditions (Terms and Conditions).
3. 'Wine Australia' means the statutory authority established under the Wine Australia Act 2013 and any representative, successor or permanent assign of Wine Australia, including representative organisations outside Australia.
4. Attendees must purchase tickets to the Event at \$60 USD plus fees. They must print their ticket out and display that or have their e-ticket (via the Eventbrite app) on their phone to be eligible to enter the Event.
5. Attendees must be at least 21 years of age with a valid government-issued ID to be allowed to enter the venue and attend the Event, even if they have paid for a ticket. Everyone must show a valid ID. The only forms of ID we accept are the attendees' US state-issued Driver's License, ID Card or Passport. Absolutely no exceptions.
6. Attendees acknowledge photos and videos of attendees (individuals, groups) are taken at the event by the organizer and may be used later for marketing the Event(s).
7. Wine Australia will not allow the entry of children under the age of 21 years to the venue or the Event.
8. Attendees must select which day they wish to attend the Event. Each ticket is only valid on the date of the ticket without exception and is not transferrable to another day or another person other than the name of the ticket holder. Any tickets purchased through third party websites will not be accepted. There shall be no refunds on the purchase of any tickets.
9. Wine Australia reserves the right to refuse entry into the venue or remove anyone from the venue who is intoxicated. Attendees are expected to behave in a professional and appropriate manner at the Event. Wine Australia reserves the right to refuse entry or require an attendee to leave if behaviour is deemed unacceptable.
10. Wine Australia, at its sole and absolute discretion, may refuse to accept the entry of an attendee.
11. If the Event does not attract the minimum number of targeted attendees or, if in the reasonable opinion of Wine Australia, it would be in the best interests of the Australian grape and wine community to do so, Wine Australia may, at its full discretion, cancel the Event and, if so, may refund any portion of fees or charges already paid by an attendee in relation to that Event in its discretion.
12. If the Event is cancelled or varied, Wine Australia will notify the attendees as soon as practicably possible.
13. Attendees will pay to Wine Australia the ticket fee along with the additional fees in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. For the avoidance of doubt, the ticket fee covers the entry to the Event on the date/s the ticket is valid for.
14. Wine Australia may obtain attendee personal information and/or data related to the attendee (Attendee Information). Wine Australia will only share such Attendee Information in accordance with its privacy policy which can be found at <https://www.wineaustralia.com/privacy>.
15. Entry to the Event and venue is at the attendees' own risk, and by entering the attendee acknowledges that there may be certain risks by attending the Event.
16. Wine Australia will not be responsible with any loss or injury associated with attendance to the Event, unless in the case of negligence by Wine Australia.
17. The phrase 'Far From Ordinary', associated logo, artwork and other marketing material is the sole property of Wine Australia and cannot be used by an external party without prior written consent from Wine Australia.
18. These Terms shall in respects be governed by the laws of South Australia, Australia. The attendee submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in South Australia to determine any matter or dispute which arises under these Terms and Conditions.
19. If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is deemed invalid or unenforceable, all or part of that provision will be severed from the Terms and Conditions and will not affect the enforceability of the remaining provisions of the Terms and Conditions.
20. No waiver of any term shall be deemed a further or continuing waiver of such term or any other term. Any failure to assert any right under these Terms and Conditions shall not constitute a waiver of such right.
21. These Terms and Conditions constitute the entire agreement between Wine Australia and the attendee in relation to the Events.
