ABOUT THE SHIPPING APPLICATION

The Shipping Application is the approved form for a notification of intention to export defined for Australian grape products. It should be lodged with Wine Australia at least 5 days prior to the date of shipment. A Shipping Application is required for all consignments of 100 litres or more. Where the Shipping Application complies with all requirements, Wine Australia will authorise the consignment and issue an Export Permit Number to the exporter for the application of an Exit Declaration Number (EDN) from the Australian Customs Service.

Please note: 24-hour turn-around for Shipping Applications cannot be guaranteed unless each section of the application is complete.

1 EXPORTER DETAILS

Exporter ID: The identification number issued to the exporter by Wine Australia. It is not mandatory to complete this item however it will assist Wine Australia in completing the approval process.

Exporter Name: The name of the entity holding a Licence to Export Grape Products issued by Wine Australia, who has responsibility for the export of the consignment.

2 DESTINATION DETAILS

Exporter Reference: Exporter's internal reference for the consignment (ie. Order Number).

Est. Departure Date: The estimated date for the departure of the vessel or aircraft from the port of loading.

Final destination market: Where the wine will be sold. For USA and Canada, please specify the State/Province.

Customs clearance: The market where the consignment will clear customs. If different to final destination market please specify.

3 CONSIGNEE DETAILS

Consignee Name and Address: The person/company in the overseas destination to whom the goods are consigned. The consignee full name and address is required.

4 SHIPMENT DETAILS

Transportation Method: Where the method of transport is by sea, include the vessel name and voyage number. In case of air include the flight number (if available).

Exporter reference: Exporter's unique internal reference for the consignment

Port of Loading: The Australian port or airport where the consignment is loaded onto the vessel or aircraft.

Port of unloading: The last foreign port or airport where the consignment is to be unloaded from the vessel or aircraft.

5 SHIPMENT ITEMS

Product Number: The Product Number is the number granted by Wine Australia for each product approved for export. Each product must be approved before the Export Permit Number (WBC Number) can be issued.

No of cartons/vessels: The number of cartons for that product in the consignment, or the number of vessels of that product.

Items per Carton: The number of units in each carton.

Product name: Must include the vintage, brand name and variety (if claimed on the label).

Total FOB (AUD): The total free-on-board value for that product. It includes the sales value of the goods and the associated costs of placing the goods on the vessel. It excludes any insurance costs.

V11 Certificate comments: Optional. Any comments you wish to appear on the V11 certificate for that product, i.e seal number, invoice number, SKU etc.

6 DECLARATION

Declaration: The exporter or their authorised representative must complete the declaration. By signing the declaration, the exporter declares that the matters declared on the application are true.
