## Bulk wine market update February 2022

Australian bulk wine prices for the major red varieties were significantly lower in February 2022 than in the same month in the previous five years, while prices for white varieties have generally increased or remained at a similar level, except for Pinot Gris/Grigio, which has declined since February 2018.

Note: These prices relate to wine from the 2021 vintage. Sauvignon Blanc is not available on the bulk market in February 2022.

There has been a substantial decline in prices for Australian red varieties on the global bulk wine market since early 2021, after the imposition of significant tariffs on Australian wines by the Chinese government reduced export demand, and a record harvest of over 2 million tonnes increased supply.

The prices for white varieties have held up relatively well over the year, but are lower in February 2022 than they were two years ago, despite the continuing shortage of white wine on the global market.

Prices have generally stabilised in February, reflecting the lack of buying activity over the Christmas period ahead of the new vintage (Figure 2).

By contrast, prices for wines from Spain are generally higher in February 2022 than at the same time last year, particularly Spanish Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Moscatel and Sauvignon Blanc (Figure 3).
